Big One 2024 is an open competition for everyone who wants to participate, in accordance with the rules outlined in this document and all those defined by the B1G ONE staff before and during the event. Please read the following document so we can carry out the event in accordance with the times, harmony and fun that this international Pump It Up event entails.

## General rules before, during and after the tournament:

Unrestricted respect for players and competitors, organization of B1G ONE and the venue, sponsors, welcome dinners and events that B1G ONE organizes in other places. Failure to comply with this rule will be sanctioned by the B1G ONE staff according to its severity, and may even be sanctioned with a PROHIBITION from participating in the B1G ONE event permanently.

## Register

The registration consists of two stages: registration and check-in.

### About the registration

There will be two registration processes. The first will be held online **from SEPTEMBER 15th to SEPTEMBER 25th at 11:59 pm**.

The second process will be online from **SEPTEMBER 27th AT 00:01 HRS UNTIL SEPTEMBER 29th at 11:59 pm**.

**DUE TO THE HIGH NUMBER OF REGISTRATIONS, REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE MADE AT THE EVENT LOCATION. This, solely for the purpose of maintaining the itinerary of the event and respecting the assigned times for the players and those who provided us with the venue.**

Online registration will be divided into 2 regions, one in which payment will be made in advance and another, which will be paid at the venue of the event on October 11th.

Both must fill out the online pre-registration form. Those who do not register in the online registration will not be able to make the payment or register in the categories on the day of the event.

### **REGION #1 (pre-registration with advanced payment)**

\* **CHILE:** 10.000 CLP for 1 category per player and 5.000 CLP for each additional category per player. As an additional category, SHORTCUT will be 3.000 CLP

**REGION #2 (registry with payment at the venue)**

ALL OTHER COUNTRIES

They must have filled the registration form previously and pay at the CHECK-IN table of the event. The value will be 10,000 CLP for 1 category per player and 5,000 CLP for each additional category per player.

As an extra category, SHORTCUT will cost 3,000 CLP.

*For organizational reasons, we ask everyone pre-registers online as soon as the form to do so is enabled.*

About check-in:

To complete your registration process, you must be at the venue on Friday, October 11<sup>th</sup> with your OFFICIAL identification document (DNI, Identity Card, Chilean Driver's License or Passport) and proof of payment for your registration.

Check-in for all participating people will close on OCTOBER 11th, 2024 at 6:00 p.m.

About the exclusive in-game title

Only participants who have paid for their registration, CHECK-IN at the event location and participate in at least one category, will be eligible to obtain the exclusive in-game title, which will be delivered after the end of October and will be in charge of ANDAMIRO.

**It will be MANDATORY to have a Registered AM PASS at the time of registration if you want to receive the EXCLUSIVE TITLE of B1G 2024.**

## Timetable

For organizational reasons, the detailed timetable will be presented the first week of October (after the end of online pre-registration).

For all those interested in participating we recommended to be present in Santiago de Chile since Thursday, October 10th.

## About participation restrictions.

Next, we clarify in which category each player can register.

Keep in mind that the competitions in all categories seek to generate a SUITABLE space for the type of player who wishes to participate in each of them. If you do not represent the category for which you wish to register, please avoid registration as **there will be no refunds if you fail to comply with this rule.**

### 1) Beginner/Intermediate Players:

**All the arguments and/or precedents described in this point do not represent all the criteria for eliminating or incorporating players into the category, which may vary from one player to another.**

Both categories are designed for players whose level of play does not allow them to compete in higher categories. This does not necessarily mean being an average player or standing out among the best, but rather being just starting out in the game or not having the skills required for advanced categories.

The B1G ONE Staff will not be in charge of placing players in lower categories just because of the player's preference. Our goal is to promote competitiveness and encourage all participants to always seek the most enriching experience. Participating in a tournament should be a challenging event, in a way that tries to get the best out of the competitor's performance.

Additionally, our objective is to ensure that people who do correspond to some of these categories have the security that they will face people with a level and conditions suitable to demonstrate their ability.

For this reason, if a player demonstrates a level above average in the BEGINNER or INTERMEDIATE categories, the Staff will contact them to offer them the possibility of enrolling in a more advanced category, at no additional cost.

All players can participate in ONLY ONE of these categories, as long as their level of play meets the established criteria. The assignment of categories will be evaluated exclusively by the B1G ONE Staff, based solely on the player's performance. Other arbitrary factors will not be considered in any case. Players registered in the BEGINNER category will not be able to register in INTERMEDIATE, and vice versa.

2) **Old School players:**

Everyone is free to participate in this category, **except Beginner and Intermediate players.**

3) **Coop Players:**

Everyone is free to participate in this category in a two-person team. Individual competition is not allowed in any case.

4) **Speed Male, Speed Female players:**

Everyone is free to participate in this category, **except Beginner and Intermediate players.**

5) **Shortcut**

Everyone is free to participate in this category, **except Beginner and Intermediate players.**

6) **Freestyle and Old School Freestyle**

Everyone is free to participate in this category.

## General tournament rules

\*\*\*\*\*

- Only AMPASS cards provided by the organization will be used.
- All commands will be introduced by the tournament staff-referees.
- Only skin commands with arrow format will be allowed.
- For specific regulations, refer to the document of each category.

## Behaviour rules

The following actions will be sanctioned with disqualification and/or expulsion from the event:

- The event will comply with any health regulations determined by the government of Chile or the city of Santiago de Chile, this being indisputable.
- If the players do not appear at the organization's call to play, they will be eliminated from the category.
- Any damage to machines, furniture, location, etc.
- It is strictly prohibited to salivate (spit on) the pad.
- It is strictly prohibited to use any material, element and/or substance that may be a danger to the player himself or to third parties. The B1G ONE organization will have pad maintenance elements and they will be the only ones allowed to be used by players.
- Any lack of respect, physical and verbal violent action towards the organization, players or attendees is totally prohibited. They will be punished with a **4 YEARS** disqualification from participating in all events held by this organization. Same penalty if you cause any type of damage to PIU machines, furniture, location, etc.
- Economic sanctions will be applied by appropriate means.
- The use of any element that alters the surface of the panel is totally prohibited. If the modification cannot be resolved, the user of said materials will be disqualified.
- It is strictly prohibited to carry out any type of religious and/or political parodies or actions.
- It is strictly prohibited to play without appropriate footwear. You cannot play with socks, stockings, bare feet or with shoes that could damage the operation of the machine.
- **Only sports shoes will be used.**

If you have any questions about this point, contact the organization, but basically any sports shoe that has a rubber sole at an angle of 180° is accepted.

- The use of any element that alters the surface of the bar, whether liquid and/or solid, for example, baby powder, chalk or some type of magnesium powder, is totally prohibited. Only the use of gloves, which do not alter the surface of the bar, is permitted for hand protection.
- The use of drugs and/or alcohol is totally prohibited within the event facilities. This can not only cause personal conflicts for the players, but also for the organization of the event. Any competitor, assistant or staff suspected of being influenced by the use of drugs, alcohol or

any substance will be removed from the establishment by security personnel, with possible arrest by the authorities of Santiago de Chile.

***Both the organization and the venue of the event will not be responsible for any theft/loss of the personal property of any attendee, player or staff. PLEASE pay attention and take care of your belongings.***

***The organization will not keep, care for or monitor any material property.***

***The entire rules may be modified by the organization for reasons of force majeure. Their judgment will be indisputable.***

### Score recording method:

At the end of the song, the players will proceed to get off the platform so as not to accidentally press the yellow panel. This is because, after doing it 3 times, the score screen disappears, without being able to see the score and note. If this happens, the score will be taken as 0 and the grade as F, which will mean immediate disqualification from the category. If the scoring screen cannot be viewed due to some other factor (e.g. power outage), recordings will be viewed or another action specified by the organization will be performed, e.g. the player repeating the song. After getting off the platform, players must position themselves next to the screen to be photographed with their score.

Likewise, the organization has complete freedom to make the players repeat a song if they detect a malfunction of the machine or any internal or external defect that could cause an alteration in the tournament.
